The tactile quality of the stitched lavers creates depth and movement, capturing the essence of the landscape. from rolling moors and rugged coastlines to dramatic shifting skies. During the exhibition there will be demonstrations on how the paper lavers are torn and stitched to create these reimagined landscapes.

Housed in a former textile warehouse. The Garage Gallery offers an alternative exhibition venue for Colour Paper Stitch.

With its industrial heritage, stone walls, and raw textures, the space provides the perfect contrast to the delicate, layered paper and stitch work. 
