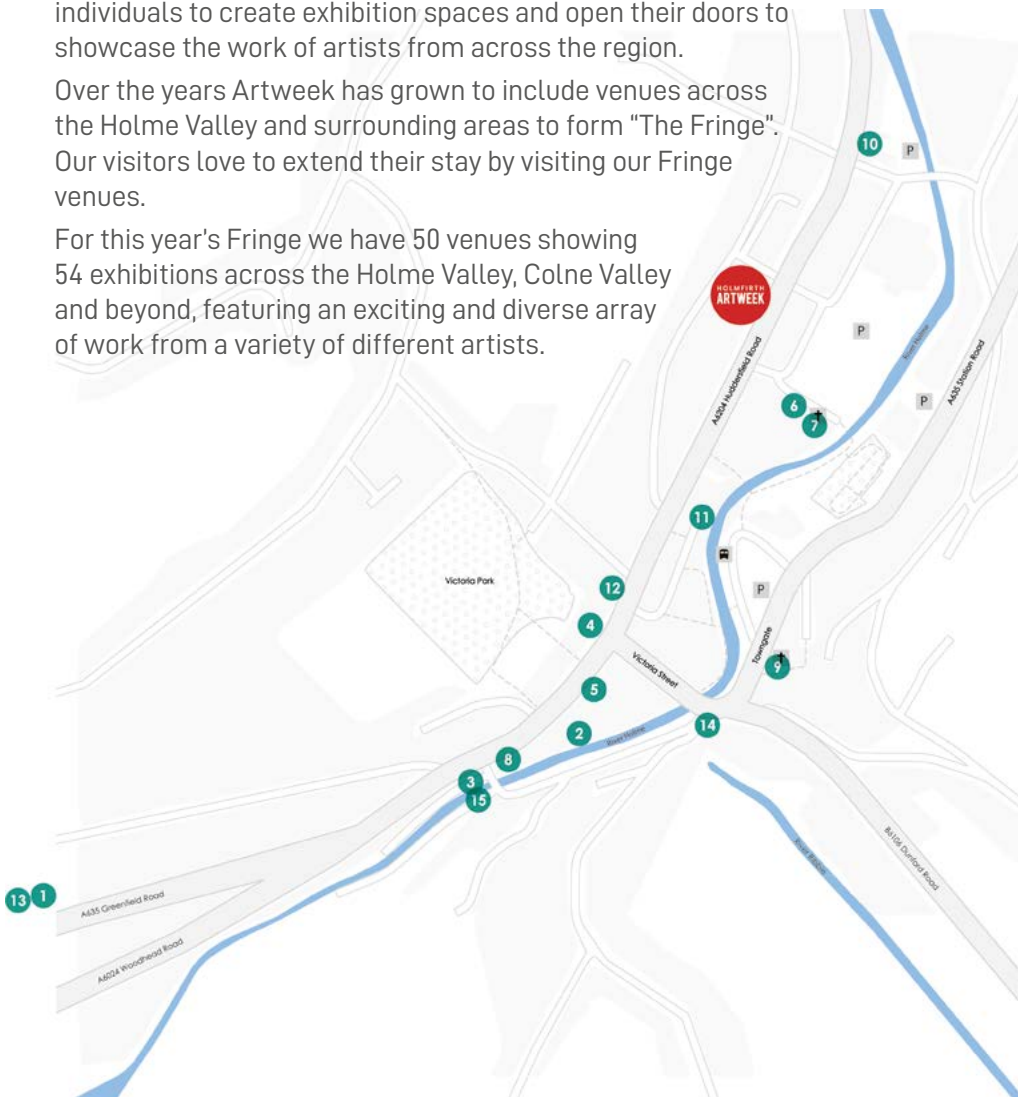
FRINGE VENUES

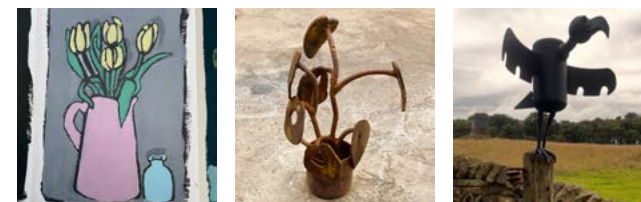

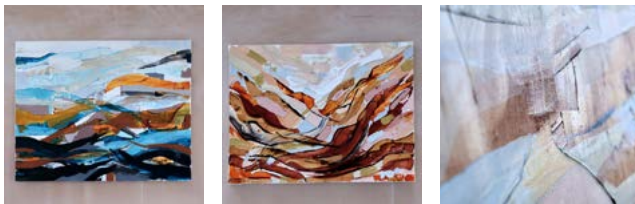

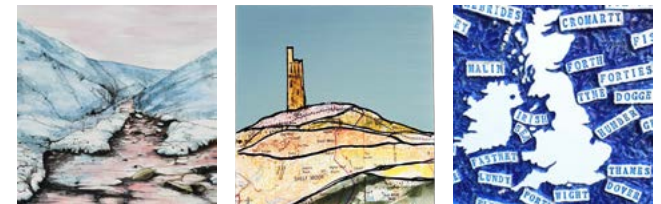

**THE EXHIBITION**

Linda Southwell creates porcelain sculptures inspired by plant and flower forms. She works from memory, developing flowers that are unique to her. Her sculptures are made slowly from hundreds of repetitively formed elements. The porcelain is pushed to its limit so that the impression of fragility is belied by the strength of the material after it has been transformed by intense heat. The scale of Linda's work varies from one-off small single flowers to large scale installations.

We are a contemporary modern German Kitchen Showroom along with Traditional shaker style displays. Positioned in the centre of Holmfirth.

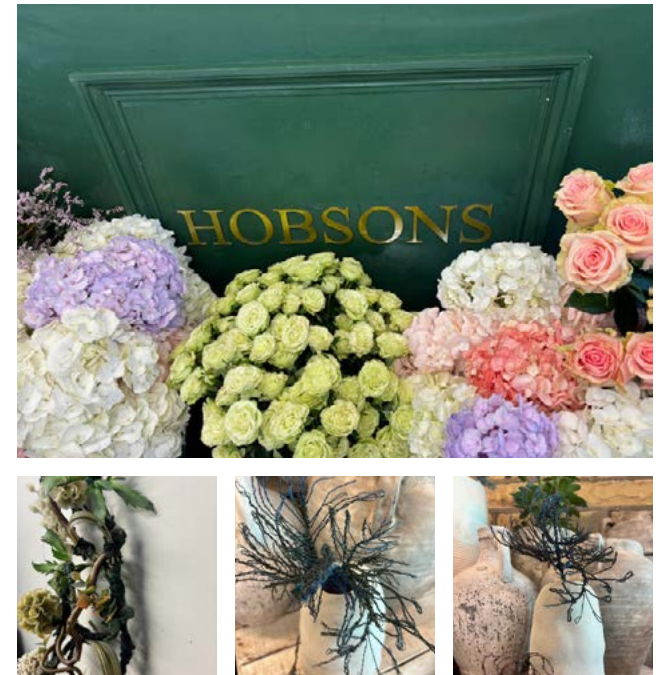

#### THE EXHIBITION

Nigel graduated from Bretton Hall College in 1992 with a BA in Fine Art and has been making high quality hand-made pottery for exhibitions and commission since. In 1995, "A Place in Time" became the first contemporary one-man ceramics show at Bury Town Art Gallery. His work has become better known, for its alchemic exploration of glaze processes creating sophisticated, multi-layered surfaces. Recent work is driven by the landscapes ephemeral nature. Its form is constantly hidden and revealed in indeterminate fashion, a constant process of growth and decay. All one needs to learn about the human condition is exposed in the process of the forming and reforming of the earth's surface.

The Tech is Holmfirth's vibrant hub for arts, wellbeing, learning and enterprise, set in a Grade II listed building. But it's more than just the place to be – the Tech transforms lives and makes a massive difference in the community. We also host monthly exhibitions showcasing talented local artists. 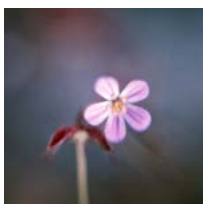

#### THE EXHIBITION

A collective exploration of the Holme Valley as it exists today. Contributors have been asked to look beyond postcard views and respond to the valley through approaches ranging from careful observation to more experimental processes - allowing space to try things out and see where they lead - tracing the landforms, habitats, waterways and architecture that define this place. The exhibition will reflect on the historic landscape as something shaped by use, weather and time, bringing together a range of responses to the Holme Valley in the present day.

#### THE VENUE

O'Briens Beer Café is a popular bar known for its craft beers, natural and low-intervention wines, all in a relaxed, welcoming atmosphere. Occupying a converted former butcher's shop in the centre of Holmfirth, we have retained many original architectural details that give the space its distinctive character. 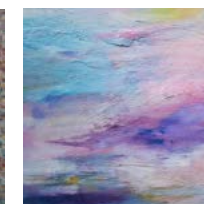
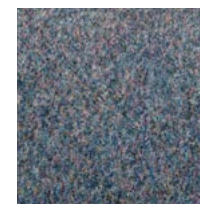

#### THE EXHIBITION

Alexandra Glew's expressive abstract works explore the sensory experience of moving through local landscapes, each piece functions as an intuitive, visual field recording. Rather than depicting landscape directly, it translates sensations, observations and fragments of connections through texture, colour, shape and mark. Through repetition, mark-making, and delicate layering, the paintings create a meditation on connection, movement, and the places we experience alone and together.

Ethan Scorer's paintings explore the interplay between creation and self-erasure. When creating a piece, any trace of the artists own hand or applicator is removed. So that each piece looks as if it has naturally emerged, or has been removed from nature and translated elsewhere. Each painting is a meditative space for the viewer to exist within. The colours and shapes evoke something known, yet ultimately unknowable.

#### THE EXHIBITION

An exhibition of abstract artworks that invite detailed observation and quiet attention. Freed from representation, they offer space for reflection rather than explanation, allowing colour, form, and rhythm to be experienced in the splendid venue of St Bartholomew's church.

#### THE VENUE

Known as the Cathedral of the Colne Valley, St Bartholomew's Church replaced two former churches. Hodgson Fowler of Durham, assisted by James Kirk of Marsden were the new architects. Foundation stones were laid in 1894 and the building, including tower, was completed in May 1911. This beautiful building holds many treasures, stained glass windows, wooden and stone carvings and original paintings.

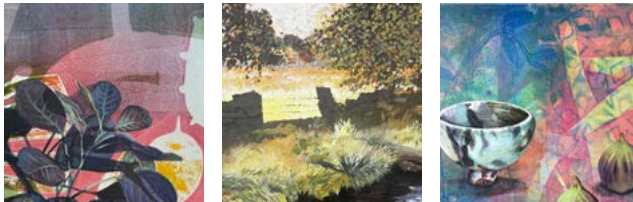
